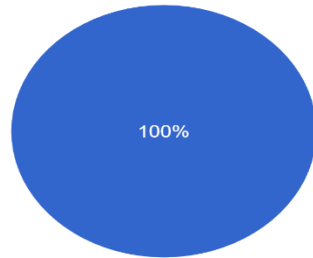

When you joined the College, how were you oriented about expectations from you and the competencies you should develop on completion of the Programme?

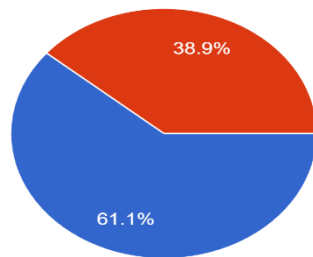

The teaching of theory courses helped you to become aware about the working of school system in the country.

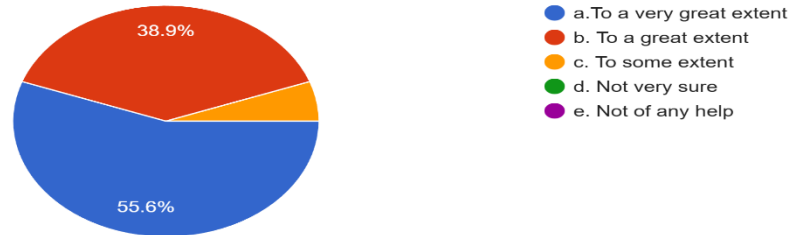

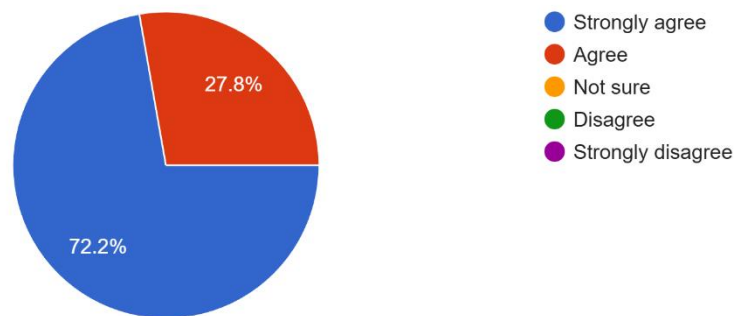
The educational documents/reports/books available at the institution helpful to understand the educational functioning

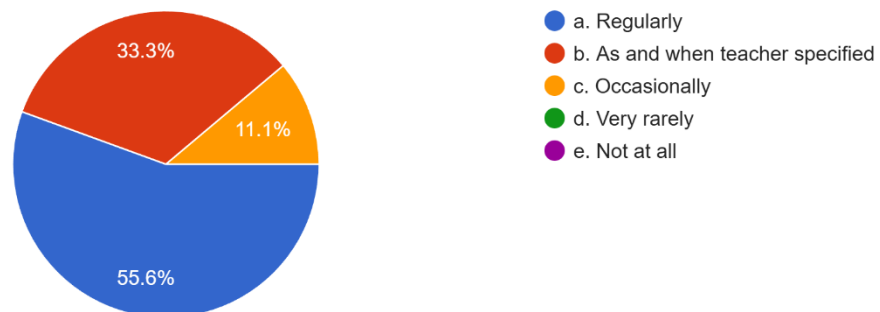
You got an exposure to multiple modes of teaching learning in the college

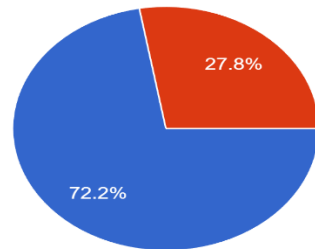
Did you get an opportunity to learn through internet-based sources during your stay in the College?

To what extent did the teaching-learning in the College enable you to be capable of meaningfully adopting ICT based learning sequences for school teaching?

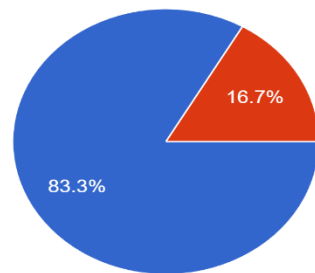

The learning activities provided in the college helped you to develop necessary competencies to become a teacher .

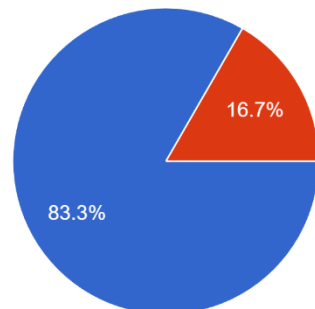

How well you were "prepared" for the practice of teaching in schools?

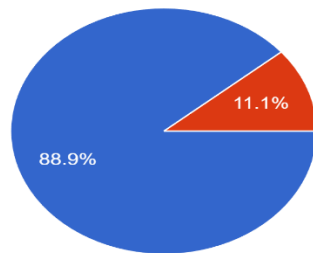

The orientation given for the school-based internship was

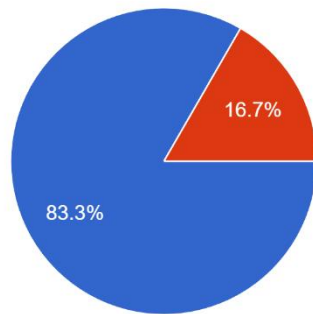

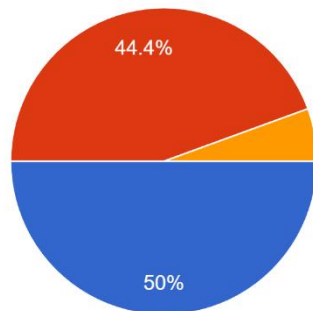

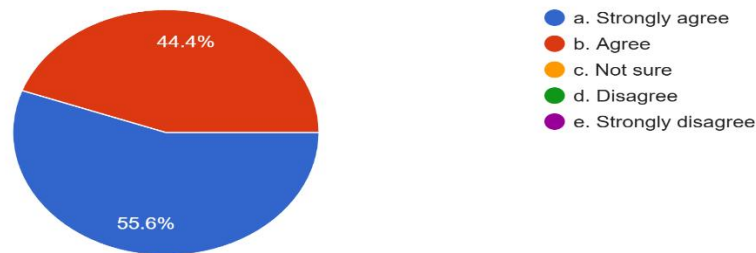

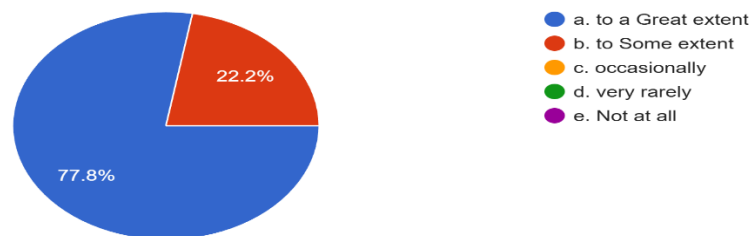
Overall quality of teaching learning and Evaluation processes in the College is good.

- **Classroom Management**
 - Ability to manage the class effectively and maintain discipline

- **Confidence as a Teacher**

 - Confidence gained through internship experience and peer learning.

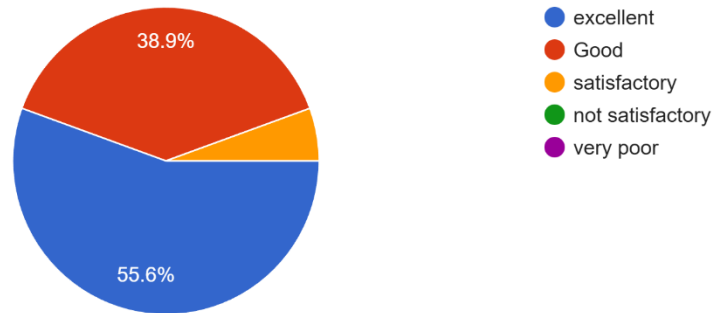
